MEADOWBROOK COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

At 7:10 pm the President, Pam Bowe, called the webcast meeting to order. There were 9 attendees, including at least 7 voting members in attendance.

Minutes Upon motion duly made and seconded, the minutes of the May 11, 2021 meeting were approved.

<u>Treasurer's Report</u> The Treasurer, Wilma Boyd, noted there was a total of \$2,260.04 in Meadowbrook Council's checking, savings, and money market accounts at BECU.

Neighborhood News Mr. Keefe reported he had received an email from Brian Dougherty at SDOT about speeding problems on 35th, saying the City's ranking of this issue was low and their funds did not allow for funding. One participant suggested the Council send a letter requesting police add patrol cars on 35th to ticket speeders. Ms. Walton agreed to provide the President with a contact at the City for the Council to write urging more police oversight and she would attend an upcoming City meeting regarding how to obtain a Neighborhood Matching Fund grant for speeding mitigation on 35th Avenue NE.

Emergency Communications HUB The President said there is a Field Exercise scheduled for September 18, 2021 from 9am to 1pm. The HUB is in the parking lot of Maple Leaf Lutheran Church. The purpose is to practice activating the HUB in the event of an emergency such as a major earthquake.

<u>Thornton Creek Alliance</u> Mr. Keefe reported the Parks Department has purchased property on NE 125th and it will make a presentation at a Thornton Creek Alliance virtual meeting on July 29th regarding their plans for the property. <u>Neighborhood Matching Fund</u> The City is having online training for persons interested in obtaining Neighborhood Matching Funds grants on July 24th and August 5th. The President urged interested members to attend.

<u>Tree Survey</u> Ms. Weinstein stated she will provide a report at the September meeting.

MCC Meeting The President said the next public meeting would be September, 2021 at 7pm. There was a discussion of possible in person meeting sites.
