## MEADOWBROOK COMMUNITY COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

At 7:02 pm the President, Pam Bowe, called the webcast meeting to order. There were 7 attendees, including 7 voting members in attendance.

Minutes Upon motion duly made and seconded, the minutes of the July 21, 2021 meeting were approved.

Treasurer's Report The President noted there was a total of \$2,260.04 in Meadowbrook Council's checking, savings, and money market accounts at BECU.

Tree Survey Ms. Weinstein stated she is ready to provide a report.

Speeding Problems on 35<sup>th</sup> Dan Keefe reported he has been told this is low on the City's priorities and they are behind on all projects due to Covid.

Thornton Creek Alliance TCA is considering contesting the Director's decision to increase the zoning for property abutting 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE to increase the density. Access for the proposed development would be on 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE, as opposed to 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE. TCA believes 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue NE should be preserved as a greenway and they are concerned about harmful impacts on the Beaver Pond Natural Area.

Emergency Communications HUB The President said there is a Field Exercise scheduled for September 18, 2021 from 9am to 1pm at the Maple Leaf Park. The practice will involve a simulated 7.2 earthquake. All north end HUBs will be participating. They are soliciting volunteers to act out roles they are given at the drill. She will send out a blast email regarding the Exercise to the MCC email list.

MCC Meeting Ms. Bowe stated the next public meeting would be November 9, 2021 at 7pm.

The meeting was adjourned at 7:28 pm.
